Go Deeper:

- 3) Do you think we still struggle with a materialistic approach to Jesus? Why or why not?
- 4) Do you think we still struggle with self-sufficient spirituality? Why or why not?
- 5) How can we question and doubt in a way that doesn't usurp God?
- 6) What was wrong with the questioning of this crowd in John 6?
- 7) Do you think Christians really believe that apart from Christ nothing satisfies? Explain your answer.
- 8) List some ways that you snack of Jesus as the bread of life all day long? Why do you think this is so important in light of the message of John 6?
- 9) Why do you think Jesus chose to answer so offensively in John 6:53-59? Do you think Jesus still does this at times?
- 10) What is God desiring to do in your life right now so that Jesus can more fully be your bread of life? How are you responding?
