## Go Deeper:

- 6) If it were you instead of these women on that morning how do you think you would have responded differently? How the same?
- 7) What it is about Jesus that brings great joy into your life? What is it that brings immense reverence/awe/fear?
- 8) What would be the equivalent today of the worship of the women in v.10?
- 9) In what ways to we tend to walk more by sight than by faith today? Where is God stretching your faith right now?
- 10) Spend some time reflecting on specific ways in which our risen savior, Jesus Christ, has turned your mourning into dancing.
