
Why Family Ministry?

God intends two institutions to be the spiritual trainers of His children: Family and Church



Family Church Co-Champions

Family and church sometimes work independently toward the same goal

God intends both family and church to work as **co-champions** to encourage, equip and hold each other accountable

- The combined impact of **co-champions** is greater than two influences independently striving for the same goal.
- Family ministry combines the efforts of family and church. Its goals are to:
 - 1) build faith and character in our sons and daughters
 - 2) fuel a passion in the heart of every generation to love God and others.

5 Reason for Family Ministry at MorningStar Baptist Church:

- Family ministry intentionally aligns us with God's design in creation in which He created the institution of marriage and family as the foundation for human life, society, and the church. (Genesis 1,2)
- Emphasizing family ministry positions us to more effectively call and equip parents to be the primary spiritual trainers of their children. (Genesis 18:18, Deuteronomy 6:5-7, Ephesians 6:4)
- Family ministry **combines** the efforts and influence of the only two institutions that are committed to the spiritual growth of our children against the myriad of influences seeking to steal the hearts of our children away from God.
- Family ministry is the most effective strategy for establishing and sustaining lasting discipleship that is passed on from generation to generation.
- 5 Strengthening families strengthens the church. Thriving churches are built upon thriving families.
